NOTE TO OBSERVERS: SPECTATORS ARE NOT AL-LOWED ON THE PRACTICE AREA DURING CLASS. If you must speak to an instructor or student, please get their attention first and someone will come to you, but for your own safety as well as the students, do not walk onto the practice area during class.

NOTE TO STUDENTS: Promotions are based on completion of a minimum number of classes and time. Therefore depending upon the individual student and their class participation and attendance, time periods between promotions may vary from student to student. Students must be evaluated by a Black Belt in order to schedule a promotion.

BELT PROMOTION FEES: (In addition to Instruction fees) All Jr. Warrior Promotions will cost \$15 and will be carried out individually with one of the black belt instructors during class time. Purple and Brown Warrior promotions will be done in front of the group.

ABOUT THE CLUB: The Jr. Warrior program will be a martial arts class that is less intensive than the Elite class and geared towards fun learning for beginning students. Along with the common blocks, punches and kicks you would find in a martial arts class, Jr. Warriors will also learn other important character building attributes such as; exercise, respect, stretching, attention, cooperation, discipline, balance, memory, coordination and friendship. The system will follow a regimented learning program which will allow for testing/evaluation of the student in four month intervals (16 classes between promotions). Every student will begin with a new white uniform with a white belt and a Coszacks Elite Defense System patch (only available to Coszacks Students). After completing the minimum 16 class intervals, the student will be cleared to take their next belt promotion with an instructor. The students will earn new white belts with colored stripes that follow our Elite promotion curriculum. The student will progress from white warrior through vellow, orange, green, blue, purple and brown warrior ranks. Class attendance and participation are a necessity for promotion. Between belt tests, the students will earn different crescent patches that can be attached to their uniform. Three patches will be earned between belt tests and will be given to the student by Master Seward.

FEES FOR INSTRUCTION

REGISTRATION FEE:: \$50 Per Student (Includes White Uniform)

PER SESSION:: Only \$5 per Class

PAY IN ADVANCE:: \$45 for 10 Classes (one free class) NOTE: Students are only charged for classes they attend.

UNIFORM PATCHES:: The cost of the uniform patches is covered in the price of each belt test. The \$15 belt test fee covers the students next warrior level belt as well as the next three patches required to reach the next belt level. Three patches will be earned between belt ranks. The following patches are earned in the following order: exercise, listening, respect, stretching, falling, attention, cooperation, blocks, discipline, balance, strikes, stances, memory, kicks, coordination, combos, forms and future black belt.

- Once a Jr. Warrior graduates to the Elite Class, they will be permitted to transfer their patches to their Coszacks Elite Uniform if they choose to do so.
- No other patches will be added to a students uniform unless approved by Master Seward.
